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Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §681, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 536, $\S\S1$ and 2 and affected by c. 604, $\S\S2$ and 3, is amended to read:

Collective bargaining agreements. This subchapter does not prevent the negotiation of collective bargaining agreements that provide greater protection to employees or applicants than is provided by this subchapter. A public employee represented by a collective bargaining agent may not be required to submit to a substance abuse test unless the policy to do so is first negotiated.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill makes it illegal for a public employee represented by a collective bargaining agent to be required to submit to a substance abuse test unless the policy to do so is first negotiated.
