2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §191, sub-§2, ¶H,** as repealed and replaced by  
PL 1981, c. 698, §176, is amended to read:

6 H. The disclosure by the State Tax Assessor of the fact  
8 that a person is or is not registered under this Title or  
disclosure of both the fact that a registration under this  
10 Title has been revoked and the reasons for revocation. This  
disclosure must be provided upon request in the form of a  
written list of all persons registered;

14 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

16 This bill requires the State Tax Assessor to provide a list  
of those who are registered with the State under the Maine  
18 Revised Statutes, Title 36. Currently, the State Tax Assessor  
may confirm that an individual entity is registered, but can not  
20 provide the same information in the form of a list.
