## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §191, sub-§2, ¶H, as repealed and replaced by PL 1981, c. 698, §176, is amended to read:

6 H. The disclosure by the State Tax Assessor of the fact that a person is or is not registered under this Title or 8 disclosure of both the fact that a registration under this Title has been revoked and the reasons for revocation. This 10 disclosure must be provided upon request in the form of a written list of all persons registered;

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill requires the State Tax Assessor to provide a list of those who are registered with the State under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 36. Currently, the State Tax Assessor may confirm that an individual entity is registered, but can not provide the same information in the form of a list.
