2	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §3305-A is enacted to read:
6	§3305-A. Survey of energy prices
-	When the State Planning Office issues a survey of energy
8	prices, it must include all generally available sources of energy whose prices are not regulated by the Public Utilities
10	Commission. The report must be limited to the survey results and may not include comment, opinion on the propriety or magnitude of
12	prices or advice as to when or under what circumstances consumers should purchase any particular energy resource.
