Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §4, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 45, Pt. A, §4, is amended to read:

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A. Licensees may not sell liquor on Sunday between the hours of 6 a.m. and 12 noon. A Class A restaurant or a Class A restaurant/lounge may commence selling liquor on Sunday at 9 a.m. only if the liquor accompanies a meal.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill amends the Sunday sales laws to allow Class A restaurants and Class A restaurant/lounges to serve liquor beginning at 9 a.m. when the liquor accompanies a meal.
