SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 147, L.D. 333, Bill, "An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$20,000,000 for Landfill Closure and Remediation"

Amend the amendment by striking out the substitute title and replacing it with the following:

**'An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$14,000,000 for Landfill Closure and Remediation, for Small Community Water Pollution Control Facilities and for the Removal of State-owned Underground Storage Tanks'**

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd indented paragraph (page 1, lines 30 to 33 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

**'Further amend the bill in the preamble in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 5 and 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "for the purchase of recycling equipment" and inserting in its place the following: 'for small community water pollution control facilities and for removal of state-owned underground storage tanks'**

Further amend the amendment in the 3rd indented paragraph in the 3rd line (page 1, line 37 in amendment) by inserting before the following: **"and"** the following: **', for small community water pollution control facilities'**

Further amend the amendment in the 4th indented paragraph in the 3rd line (page 1, line 42 in amendment) by striking out the following: **"\$13,000,000"** and inserting in its place the following: **'\$14,000,000'**

# SENATE AMENDMENT

"Do you favor a \$14,000,000 bond issue for the following purposes: \$10,000,000 for the closure and remediation of municipal solid waste landfills; \$1,000,000 for the small community program; and \$3,000,000 for the removal of state-owned underground storage tanks?"

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

#### FISCAL NOTE

The estimated cost of sending this bond issue out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the First Regular Session of the 117th Legislature. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.

If approved by the voters, the total cost of this bond issue is estimated to be \$17,927,000 with principal payments of \$14,000,000 and interest payments of approximately \$3,927,000.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds \$1,000,000 for small community water pollution control facilities.

This amendment also adds a fiscal note.
