4	The estimated cost of sending this bond issue out to							
_	referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda							
6	enacted during the First Regular Session of the 117th							
	Legislature. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one							
8	to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional							
	referendum costs an additional \$7,000.

	If approved by the voters, the total cost of this bond issue							
12	is estimated to be \$16,646,500 with principal payments of							
	\$13,000,000 and interest payments of approximately \$3,646,500.

16	STATEMENT OF FACT							
18	This amendment is the majority report of the committee.							
20	It decreases the amount available for the closure and							
	remediation of municipal solid waste landfills from \$20,000,000							
22	to \$10,000,000; and it adds \$3,000,000 for the removal of							
	state-owned underground storage tanks.

	The amendment also increases the term of the bond from 5							
26	years to 10 years and adds a fiscal note.
