COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 239, L.D. 341, Bill, "An Act to Allow Restaurants to Sell Liquor on Sunday Mornings"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Allowing restaurants to sell liquor on Sunday mornings will result in insignificant increases of General Fund revenue from the tax on liquor sales.'
