Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §702, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. Discrimination among utilities. Except as expressly provided in this Title, the commission may not give any undue or unreasonable preference, advantage, prejudice or disadvantage to a particular utility or class of utilities, compared with another utility or class of utilities providing the same type of service. The commission shall bring its rules and practices into compliance with this subsection by January 1, 1996.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill prohibits the different treatment by the Public Utilities Commission of utilities providing the same service, which includes requiring certain utilities, but not others providing the same type of service, to provide higher interest rates on customer deposits or to provide subsidies to low-income customers.
