2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2380, sub-§3,** as enacted by PL 1993, c.  
683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

6 **3. Reflecting mirrors, tarp and tarp hardware.** A portion  
8 of a vehicle or load, except a reflecting mirror and a tarp and  
10 tarp hardware used to secure a load, may not project beyond the  
side of that vehicle to make a total width greater than specified  
in this section.

16 This bill exempts a tarp and tarp hardware used to secure  
loads on commercial trucks from the width restrictions for trucks.
