Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §2528, sub-§10, as amended by PL 1991, c. 323, is further amended to read:

6 Election by plurality vote; tie vote. Election must be by plurality vote. In the case of a tie vote, the meeting must be adjourned to a day certain, when ballots are again cast for the candidates tied for the office in question, unless the 10 municipality's-legislative-body-has-provided-by-ordinance-that any all but one tied candidate may withdraw from a subsequent 12 election by delivering written notice of withdrawal signed by the candidate and notarized to the municipal offices within the 5-day period following the election. After the 5-day period has 14 expired, the municipal officers shall call a run-off election between the remaining candidates by posting a warrant in the 16 manner required for calling a town meeting. If only candidate remains, that candidate is declared the winner 18 sworn into office.

This bill removes the requirement in secret ballot elections of candidates for municipal office that in order to allow withdrawal from a run-off election between or among tied candidates, a municipality must adopt an ordinance providing for such withdrawal. Under this bill, any tied candidate may withdraw.
