Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §14203, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1993, c. 179, 4 §1, is further amended to read:
- 6 **1. Exemptions.** The prohibitions and penalties of this chapter do not apply to the following persons when acting within 8 the scope of their profession or occupation:
- 10 A. Persons authorized by law of this State to practice medicine and surgery and-persons-under-the-supervision-and 12 centrel-ef-these-persons;
- 14 B. Commissioned medical officers of the United States Armed Forces;
- C. Registered nurses, licensed practical nurses and nurse's aides;
- D. Persons who practice upon members of their immediate families or on persons residing in their household and who
 receive no payment for such practice; and
- 24 E. Persons employed by licensed establishments who provide shampooing services within the licensed establishments+-and.
- F.--Persons-employed-to-apply-special-make-up-designed-for theater-lighting-to-a-person-who-requires-this-make-up-for an-appearance-in-the-theater-or-a-movie/on-television-or-as 30 a-model.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the license exemption for persons under the supervision and control of doctors, and persons employed applying special makeup designed for theater lighting to a person who requires this makeup for an appearance in the theater or a movie, on television or as a model.
