COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 250, L.D. 352, Bill, "An Act to Authorize the Broadcasting of Information about Persons Who Are Delinquent with Child Support Payments"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Human Services may experience an increase in Other Special Revenue from increased child support collections as a result of the department's authority to publicize information about non-supporting parents on radio and television. The increased revenue may also result in General Fund and Federal Expenditure Fund savings in the Aid to Families with Dependent Children program. The exact amounts can not be determined.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
