Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §14202, sub-§3-A is enacted to read:

6       **3-A. Demonstrator.** "Demonstrator" means any person who  
8 engages on behalf of a manufacturer, wholesaler, retailer or  
10 distributor in demonstrating the use of any machine or other  
12 article pertaining to cosmetology or barbering without charge to  
14 the person who is subject to the demonstration. The term  
16 "demonstrator" does not include one who performs such a  
18 demonstration for the benefit of persons who have a certificate  
20 to practice cosmetology or barbering under this chapter or under  
22 the licensing provisions of any other state.

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### STATEMENT OF FACT

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20       This bill provides a definition of "demonstrator" which was  
22 omitted in the Act that created the Board of Barbering and  
Cosmetology by merging the State Board of Barbers and the State  
Board of Cosmetology.
