Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires the municipality of Presque Isle to expand its water and sewer districts and that a public referendum be held. The additional costs of this state mandate are likely to be significant for expanding the districts and relatively minor for the public referendum; the exact amounts can not be determined at this time. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.'
