SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 270, L.D. 372, Bill, "An Act to Appropriate Funds for the Expansion and Renovation of the Norway Armory"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1513, sub-§1-F is enacted to read:

1-F. Transfer from Maine Rainy Day Fund; armory expansion and renovation. Notwithstanding section 1585, an amount of \$542,937 in fiscal year 1994-95 may be transferred from the available balance in the Maine Rainy Day Fund to the "Capital Construction - Repairs - Improvements" account in the Department of Defense and Veterans' Services to be made available by financial order upon the recommendation of the State Budget Officer and approval of the Governor to be used for the State's matching share of the costs of expansion and renovation of the Norway Armory.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment authorizes the transfer of \$542,937 from the Maine Rainy Day Fund in fiscal year 1994-95 to be used in the State's matching share of the costs of expansion renovation of the Norway Armory. This transfer will match \$1,326,053 of federal funds, distributed directly from the United States Department of Defense.
