

2 **Emergency preamble. Whereas,** Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

6 **Whereas,** the State is in danger of losing federal matching
funds for the expansion of the Norway Armory project; and

8 **Whereas,** there is a need to obligate state funds as quickly
as possible; and

12 **Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
14 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore,

18 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

20 **Sec. 1. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated
from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

34 Provides funds to be used for the State's

36 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the
38 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

42 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

44 This bill provides a General Fund appropriation of \$542,937
to the Department of Defense and Veterans' Services. These funds
will be used for the State's matching share of the costs of
46 expansion and renovation of the Norway Armory.
