HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 274, L.D. 376, Bill, "An Act to Exempt the State from the Mandatory Use of Reformulated Fuel"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 48 in L.D.) by striking the following: "immediately"

Further amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of the last sentence (page 2, lines 1 to 4) and inserting in its place the following:

'The Department of Environmental Protection shall study the economic effects of requiring reformulated gasoline in those counties and the effect on vehicles and machinery using reformulated gasoline and report its findings to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resource matters by January 1, 1998.'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.


