HOUSE AMENDMENT "b" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 274, L.D. 376, Bill, "An Act to Exempt the State from the Mandatory Use of Reformulated Fuel"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1661-D is enacted to read:

§1661-D. Sale of gasoline with increased oxygen

A person may not sell or deliver for sale in this State gasoline containing a higher oxygen content than gasoline sold in the State prior to July 1, 1994.'
