

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §2132, sub-§4** is enacted to read:

6 4. Credit for incineration. The use of materials that  
8 would otherwise be recycled as a fuel in an incineration facility  
10 constitutes recycling for the purpose of determining whether the  
12 recycling goals established in subsection 1 are met.

14 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

16 This bill allows materials used as fuels in incineration facilities that would otherwise be recycled to count toward meeting state municipal solid waste recycling goals.
