	The original bill sets forth conditions under which ar innkeeper can refuse accommodations or eject a guest.
	This amendment makes the following changes.
į	<ol> <li>It eliminates the innkeeper's ability to require identification containing a photograph.</li> </ol>
	2. It clarifies that an innkeeper may not refuse accommodations to a minor solely because that person is a minor.
	3. It eliminates a provision that states that it is not the intention of the legislation to prohibit an innkeeper from accommodating hunters.
	4. It broadens the prohibition against using the provisions of the legislation to be discriminatory in refusing
