Amend the amendment by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the emergency clause.


All of the various fiscal impacts are removed as a result of this amendment. The exemption of certain off-track betting parlors from certain payment requirements will reduce funds collected by the Harness Racing Commission, within the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources, for distribution to racetracks. The estimated reduction in dedicated revenue to the commission is \$55,680 in fiscal year 1996-97. The removal of the sunset date for this and other exemptions will result in annual reductions of \$168,980 in dedicated revenues collected by the commission for distribution to various harness racing-related functions beginning in fiscal year 1997-98.

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 296, L.D. 400

This amendment may result in additional collections of dedicated revenue by the Department of Public Safety. The exact amount can not be determined at this time.

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the emergency preamble and the emergency clause from Senate Amendment "A".
