16 The Chief of the State Police may issue licenses to operate beano or bingo games on a monthly basis to any volunteer fire 18 department or any agricultural fair association or bona fide charitable, educational, political, 20 recreational, fraternal, patriotic, religious or organization that was in existence at least 2 years prior to its application for a license, when sponsored, operated and conducted 22 for the exclusive benefit of that organization by duly authorized 24 members. The Chief of the State Police may also issue a license to any auxiliary associated with an organization, department or association qualified for a license under this section if the 26 auxiliary has been in existence at least 2 years before applying 28 for a license and the games are sponsored, operated and conducted for the exclusive benefit of the auxiliary by duly authorized 30 members of the auxiliary. Proceeds from any game conducted by the auxiliary or the auxiliary's parent organization may not be 32 used to provide salaries, wages or other remuneration to members, employees of the auxiliary or officers or its organization, except as provided in sections 326 and 335. The 2 34 years' limitation does not apply to any ehartered--pests--ef veterans -- organizations, -- nationally - established, organizations in 36 this State having a charter from a national organization, or auxiliaries of those posts organizations, even though the posts 38 organizations have not been in existence for 2 years prior to their application for a license ner--does--the. The 2 years' 40 limitation does not apply to any volunteer fire department or rescue unit or auxiliary of that department or unit. A license 42 may be issued to an agricultural fair association when sponsored, 44 operated and conducted for the benefit of such agricultural fair association.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'

**FISCAL NOTE** 2 1995-96 1996-97 4 **REVENUES** 6 Other Funds (\$13,920) (\$55,680)8 All of the various fiscal impacts are removed as a result of The exemption of certain off-track betting 10 this amendment. parlors from certain payment requirements will reduce funds collected by the Harness Racing Commission, within the Department 12 of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources, for distribution to racetracks. The estimated reductions in dedicated revenue to the 14 commission are \$13,920 and \$55,680 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1.6 1996-97, respectively. The removal of the sunset date for this and other exemptions will result in annual reductions of \$168,980 revenues collected by the 18 dedicated commission distribution to various functions related to harness racing 20 beginning in fiscal year 1997-98. This amendment may result in additional collections of 22 dedicated revenue by the Department of Public Safety. The exact 2.4 amount can not be determined at this time. **SUMMARY** 26 28 During the First Regular Session of the 117th Legislature, L.D. 637 was introduced to address the reduced payment issue described in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 8, section 275-0. 30 However, when the original document was written and the 32 subsequent revision was enacted the payment required in Title 8, section 275-J, subsection 1, paragraph A was not included. 34 error was not discovered until after enactment of the document. This amendment will correct the oversight that occurred in the 36 previous legislative session. This amendment also repeals the July 2, 1997 sunset of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 8, 38 section 275-O. 40 Current law requires that an organization must have been in existence for at least 2 years prior to applying for a beano 42 Chartered posts of nationally established veterans' organizations are exempt from the 2-year requirement. 44 amendment expands the exemption from the 2-year requirement to cover all organizations in this State having a charter from a 46 national organization.
