2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2302, sub-§1, ¶¶F, G and H,** as enacted by PL
1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, are amended to
6 read:

8 F. Must be equipped with a system of mirrors that ~~give~~
gives the seated operator a view of the way to each side of
10 the bus, and of the area immediately in front of the front
bumper;

12 G. May be equipped with a system of stop arms to be
operated only with the red signal lights; ~~and~~

14 H. May be equipped with reflective strips of national
16 school bus yellow; ~~and~~

18 **Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §2302, sub-§1, ¶I** is enacted to read:

20 I. May have the name of the school district in letters not
more than 6 inches high on the side of the bus.
