17. Individual retirement accounts. The debtor's right to an individual retirement allowance is not subject to execution, garnishment, attachment or any other process. This subsection may not in any way interfere with the jurisdiction of a court of this State to determine the division of marital property in an alimony, child support or divorce proceeding that is expressly preserved by this section.
