24	This bill includes charter language for the Bangor Water
26	District that may go beyond the statutory property tax exemption for water district property by adding treatment facilities to the list of exempt items. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, the
28	State is required to reimburse municipalities for 50% of the lost
30	property tax revenues due to new or expanded property tax exemptions.
32	This bill requires the Bangor Water District to relinquish
34	water rights to 2 ponds and to pay taxes on certain formerly tax-exempt properties. The additional costs of this state mandate can not be determined at this time. Pursuant to the
36	Mandate Preamble, the 2/3 vote of all members elected to each
38	House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.'
