An Act to Amend the County Budget Approval Process for Cumberland County.

2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 4	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §741, as amended by PL 1989, c. 104, Pt. C, $\S$ 8 and 10, is repealed.
4	330 and 10, is repeated.
6	Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §741-A is enacted to read:
8	§741-A. Cumberland County Budget Committee
10	Notwithstanding sections 701 and 702, the Cumberland County Budget Committee is established and, working in concert with the
12	county commissioners, is responsible for establishing the county budget as provided in this article. The county commissioners
14	shall appropriate money for county expenditures according to the budget established in accordance with this article.
16	1. Membership; caucus; election. The Cumberland County
18	Budget Committee consists of the Cumberland County Commissioners and 9 municipal officers. The county commissioners serve on the
20	budget committee in an advisory capacity only and may not vote on any committee matter. The municipal officers are elected in
22	accordance with this section.
24	A. Three members must be from each commissioner's district. No more than one member may reside in the same
26	municipality.
28	<u>B. On or before August 15th of each year the county commissioners shall notify all municipal officers to caucus</u>
30	by county commissioner district at a specified date, time and place for the purpose of electing members to the budget
32	committee. Public notice of the meeting must be issued at least 10 days before the meeting is held.
34	C. The commissioner for each district shall serve as the
36	nonvoting moderator for that district caucus. At the caucus, the municipal officers shall nominate by motion from
38	the floor proposed members to fill any vacancies on the budget committee. For each vacancy the nominee receiving
40	the most votes from among the officers present and voting is elected as a budget committee member.
42	D. Committee membership terminates when a budget committee
44	member ceases to be a municipal officer or to reside in the commissioner district from which elected. Vacancies
46	occurring on the budget committee must be filled by the committee, subject to confirmation by a majority of the
48	county commissioners, for the balance of the unexpired term. The person appointed to fill the vacant office must

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2	be a municipal officer in the same commissioner district as the person vacating the office.
<b>4</b> 6	<b>2. Chair; terms; compensation; procedures.</b> Administration of the budget committee is as follows.
8	A. The budget committee shall select its own chair, vice-chair and secretary each year.
10	B. Members serve for 3-year terms and may not serve more than 2 consecutive terms.
12	C. Members may be compensated. The amount and conditions
14	must be unanimously approved by the budget committee and the commissioners.
16	D. The committee shall adopt rules of procedure and bylaws
18	each year. In a procedural situation not addressed by these rules and bylaws, Robert's Rules of Order prevail.
20	E. The county commissioners shall provide the budget
22	committee with necessary clerical assistance, office expenses and suitable meeting space as well as access to
24	appropriate county files and information.
26 28	3. Meetings. The budget committee shall conduct its meetings in public and in accordance with this subsection.
20	A. The county commissioners shall call an organizational
30	<u>meeting of the budget committee within 2 weeks after caucus</u> <u>elections.</u>
32	B. The county commissioners or the chair of the budget
34	committee may call a meeting for the purpose of discussing county financial matters and approving a county budget.

40	Sec. 4. 30-A MRSA §742-A is enacted to read:
42	§742-A. Budget procedures
44	<b>1. Budgetary planning meetings.</b> During the month of September county commissioners shall meet with department heads
46	to establish their budgetary needs for the ensuing year. County budget committee members shall attend these meetings, which must
48	be held in the county courthouse and must be open to the public.
50	2. Draft budget. On or before October 1st the county commissioners shall submit a draft budget to the budget committee.

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- 3. Proposed budget. The budget committee shall review the draft budget with the commissioners at meetings during the month
   of October and shall prepare a proposed budget. The budget committee may increase, decrease or alter the draft budget
   provided that:
- 8 A. The budget committee enters into its minutes an explanation for any suggested change in the estimated 10 expenditures and revenues initially presented by the county commissioners; and
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B. In the proposed budget, the total estimated revenue, together with the amount of county tax to be levied, equals the total estimated expenditures.

4. Public hearings. Public hearings on the proposed budget
 shall be held by the budget committee and county commissioners in
 each commissioner's district before November 30th. Notice of
 these hearings must be given at least 10 days before the hearing
 in newspapers of general circulation within the county. Written
 notice and a copy of the proposed budget must be sent by mail, or
 delivered in person, to the clerk of each municipality in the
 county. The municipal clerk shall notify the municipal officials
 of the receipt of the proposed budget and the date of the

5. Adoption of final budget. After the public hearings are completed, the budget committee may further increase, decrease, alter or revise the proposed budget based on information obtained during the public hearing process. The proposed budget must be finally approved by a majority vote of the budget committee at a duly called meeting not later than December 15th. The budget committee shall send the approved budget to the county commissioners. The budget sent to the commissioners is final
unless, by December 31st, the commissioners make changes in the approved budget and adopt the modified budget by unanimous vote.

6. Effect of adoption. Once the budget is finalized as
 provided in subsection 5, it is final and not subject to further
 action by the county commissioners or the budget committee. No
 expenses may be incurred in excess of those approved in the final
 budget.

# 7. Interim budget. Until a budget is finally approved, the county shall operate on an interim budget, which may not exceed the previous year's budget.

#### Sec. 6. 30-A MRSA §743-A is enacted to read:

#### §743-A. Filing of county budget

<u>A copy of the adopted budget must be filed with the State</u> 6 <u>Auditor on forms approved by the Department of Audit and must be</u> retained by the State Auditor for 3 years.

Sec. 7. 30-A MRSA §744, as amended by PL 1989, c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is repealed.

#### 14 §744-A. Sunset

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- 16 The Cumberland County Budget Committee terminates at the end of the fiscal year in which either a county manager form of 18 government or county administrator form of government is implemented in Cumberland County.
- Sec. 9. 30-A MRSA §§745 and 746, as amended by PL 1989, c. 22 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, are repealed.

Sec. 10. Transition. This Act does not terminate the terms of the members of the Cumberland County Budget Advisory Committee.
Members of the advisory budget committee on the effective date of this Act continue to hold office as members of the Cumberland
County Budget Committee created by this Act until the term to which they were appointed expires. At that time vacancies must be filled as provided by this Act.

32 Sec. 11. Implementation. For 1995 only, the meeting of municipal officers called by the county commissioners for the 34 purpose of filling vacancies on the Cumberland County Budget Committee may occur after August 15th. That meeting must be held 36 and members elected to consider the county budget for 1996 as soon after this Act becomes law as is possible.

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#### **STATEMENT OF FACT**

42 This bill abolishes the current Cumberland County Budget Advisory Committee and replaces it with the Cumberland County 44 Budget Committee. The new budget committee, working in conjunction with the county commissioners, is responsible for The bill establishes a 46 developing the annual county budget. collaborative process between the commissioners and the committee 48 in reviewing department requests, sharing budgetary information and approving a final budget. The budget approved by the budget 50 committee is final unless changed by the county commissioners by unanimous vote. The membership, gualifications, terms and

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	procedures of the new budget committee are similar to those of
2	the old advisory budget committee. The bill contains transition
	provisions to guide implementation. If Cumberland County
4	establishes a county manager style of government, the Cumberland
	County Budget Committee is terminated.

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
