20	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 163, L.D. 424, Bill, "An Act Concerning Juveniles Hunting without Adult Supervision"
22	Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
24	'FISCAL NOTE
26	This bill establishes a new Class E crime. If a jail
28	sentence is imposed, the additional costs to the counties are estimated to be \$83.22 per day for each offender. These costs
30	are not reimbursed by the State. The number of prosecutions that may result in a jail sentence and the resulting costs to the
32	county jail system are expected to be insignificant.
34	The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system
36	can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may increase
38	General Fund revenue by minor amounts.
40	The additional enforcement costs can be absorbed by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife utilizing existing
42	budgeted resources.'
