2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §2185** is enacted to read:

6 **§2185. Cancellation of policies of elected officials**

8 It is an unfair trade practice under this chapter for any
10 insurer, agent or broker to cancel or refuse to renew the
12 insurance policy or contract of any person who has been elected
14 to political office solely because that person is serving or has
16 served as an elected official.

18 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

20 This bill makes it an unfair trade practice for an insurer to cancel or refuse to renew the insurance policy or contract of any person who has been elected to political office solely because that person is serving or has served as an elected official.
