Sec. 1. Department of Administrative and Financial Services directed to assume auditing functions located in certain departments. Resolved:

That the Department of Administrative and Financial Services identify all auditing functions currently being performed by departments in State Government and assume these responsibilities effective July 1, 1996. The department must provide to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs a list of those agencies with auditing functions, a summary of savings realized as a result of the implementation of this resolve and the necessary implementing legislation, no later than February 1, 1996.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This resolve directs the Department of Administrative and Financial Services to assume any auditing functions currently located within other departments in State Government. The resolve also directs the department to report to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs on the cost savings.
