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## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment uses the term "lane mile" to clarify the extent to which distribution will increase for roads with more than 2 lanes. Accordingly, the formula for distribution is changed to calculate distribution on a lane-mile basis. This amendment also adds a fiscal note, an allocation section and an effective date to the bill. It specifies that the change in distribution will begin with payments due March 1, 1997.
