### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §254, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is amended to read:

5. Medication. The commissioner may adopt or amend rules for the administration of medication in public or approved private schools. Medication may not be administered only by unlicensed licensed personnel at these schools, --except--as previded-by-the-written-prescription-of-a-physician-or-dentist-or by--the-written-permission-of-the-parent-or-guardian-of-the individual-receiving-the-medication.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill requires that only licensed personnel may administer medications in the State's public schools.
