COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 350, L.D. 470, "Resolve, to Require the Special Commission to Erect a Plaque in the Hall of Flags Honoring Medal of Honor Recipients from Maine to Submit 2 Reports and to Appoint Members by May 1, 1995"

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, to Require the Special Commission to Erect a Plaque in the Hall of Flags Honoring Medal of Honor Recipients from Maine to Submit 2 Reports'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the resolve in section 3 by striking out all of section 5 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 5. Consultation; reports. Resolved: That the commission shall consult with the State House and Capital Park Commission to ensure the appropriateness of the location and design of the new plaque within the Hall of Flags. When they have agreed upon an appropriate location and design, but not later than September 1, 1995, the commission shall submit its initial report to the Executive Director of the Legislative Council. A final report must be submitted to the Executive Director of the Legislative Council by October 30, 1995.'

Further amend the resolve by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes the May 1st deadline for appointing commission members and alters the title of the resolve to reflect that change. It also requires the Special Commission to Erect a Plaque in the Hall of Flags Honoring Medal of Honor Recipients from Maine to consult with the State House and Capitol Park Commission to determine an appropriate location and design for the plaque.
