HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 357, L.D. 477, Bill, "An Act to Increase Police Authority in Certain Cases of Disorderly Conduct"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 3 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 31 and 32 in amendment) by striking out the following: "others, including law enforcement officers" and inserting in its place the following: 'another person, who may be a law enforcement officer'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment makes technical changes to the bill and further clarifies that law enforcement officers may act as complainants in certain instances of disorderly conduct.
