	1. Credit. A taxpayer that does not constitute an
8	employing unit is allowed a credit against the tax imposed by
	this Part for each taxable year equal to the amount of health
10	insurance premiums paid by the taxpayer.
12	2. Limitation. This credit is not allowed to any taxpayer
	who is eligible to be covered by a health insurance program
14	offered by the taxpayer's employer. This credit may not exceed
	\$4,000 in any tax year. In no case may this credit reduce the
16	Maine income tax to less than zero.
18	3. Application. This section applies to any tax year
	beginning on or after January 1, 1996.
