COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 372, L.D. 507, Bill, "An Act to Exclude Certain Parks from the Definition of Mobile Home Parks"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the last line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "seasonal basis" the following: 'for migratory labor'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in the last line (page 1, line 19 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "seasonal basis" the following: 'for migratory labor'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Excluding seasonal mobile home parks from the definition of mobile home parks will result in insignificant reductions of dedicated revenue to the Manufactured Housing Board from licensing fees.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that mobile home parks that are operated only for migratory laborers on a seasonal basis are exempt from regulation under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10, chapters 951 and 953. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
