Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as fol	lows
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Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §521, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

5. Application. An application must be accompanied by the certificate of a physician as to that person's physical disability. A person whem-a-physician-certifies-to-have-a permanent-handicap--is--not--required--to--submit--an--annual eertificate must submit such a certificate annually in order to renew registration plates bearing the handicap symbol.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that a person who has registration plates with the handicap symbol submit annually a certificate of a physician as to that person's physical disability in order to renew the plates.
