Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §521, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683,
4 Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

This bill requires that a person who has registration plates
with the handicap symbol submit annually a certificate of a
18 physician as to that person's physical disability in order to
renew the plates.
