COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 377, L.D. 512, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Limitation on Damages in State Tort Claims Actions to Allow for the Accrual of Post-judgment Interest"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Allowing the payment of post-judgment interest in excess of current limitations may result in additional minor costs to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Risk Management Division. These costs should not result in increased insurance premiums.'
