**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. 13-A MRSA §714, sub-§11, ¶F,** as enacted by PL 1971, c.  
4 439, §1, is repealed.

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**Sec. 2. 13-A MRSA §714, sub-§11-A** is enacted to read:

11-A. The duties of the clerk are ministerial only and the  
10 clerk is not liable in that capacity for any liabilities of the  
12 corporation, including, without limitation, debts, claims, taxes,  
14 fines or penalties.

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**STATEMENT OF FACT**

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This bill clarifies that the duties of a corporate clerk are  
18 ministerial only and that the clerk is not liable in that  
capacity for liabilities of the corporation.

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
