	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
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	Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §1044-A, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 672,
4	Pt. A, §25, is amended to read:
6	For the purpose of providing revenues to defray the expense
	of the inspection and analysis prescribed in this subchapter, the
8	commissioner shall license retail-seed-dealers-and seed labelers.
	The commissioner shall prescribe the license application form.
10	License fees established under this subchapter may be collected
	on other than an annual basis if the lieenses license required in
12	this section are is issued in conjunction with a nurserymen's
	nursery operator's license issued under Title 32, section 1901.
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	Sec. 2. 7 MRSA §1044-A, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 672,
16	Pt. A, §25, is repealed.
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	STATEMENT OF FACT
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	This bill repeals the requirement that retail seed dealers
22	obtain a retail seed dealer's license.

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
