20	Act to Stop the Alewives Restoration Program in the St. Croix River"
22	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the
24	enacting clause the following:
26	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
28	as emergencies; and
30	Whereas, the bass fishery in the Woodland and Grand Falls
32	flowages along the St. Croix River and its associated tributaries and lakes is extremely valuable to the economy of the State; and
34	Whereas, alewives and bass compete for the same food source;

38	Whereas, that competition could significantly affect the bass fishery; and
40	Whereas, the alewife run in the St. Croix River normally

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

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## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 385, L.D. 520

2	Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in
4	its place the following:
6	'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA, §6134 is enacted to read:
8	§6134. Alewives passage; fishways on the St. Croix River
10	By May 1, 1995, the commissioner and the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall ensure that fishways on the
12	Woodland Dam and the Grand Falls Dam, both located on the St. Croix River, are configured or operated in a manner that prevents
14	the passage of alewives.
16	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'
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20	STATEMENT OF FACT
22	Although the original bill would prevent the Department of Marine Resources and the Department of Inland Fisheries and
24	Wildlife from initiating new alewife restoration programs, it would not stop the existing program on the St. Croix River.
26	This amendment replaces the original bill with new language
28	that would stop alewife passage through the Grand Falls Dam and the Woodland Dam on the St. Croix River. This is accomplished by
30	requiring that the Commissioner of Marine Resources and the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife act to ensure that
32	by May 1st of this year those fishways are configured or operated in a manner that will prevent the passage of alewives.
34	The existing fishways at those dams can be modified to
36	prevent the passage of alewives by placing screens in the fishway, removing some baffles to increase water speed or adding
38	planks in the fishway to create a plunge.
40	This amendment also changes the bill to an emergency to ensure that the modifications on those fishways are made in time
42	to stop the passage of alewives during their run up the river in early May.
