Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §6452, as amended by PL 1989, c. 730, is repealed.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill repeals the law that establishes in the public schools a screening process for scoliosis and related spinal abnormalities.
