	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA c. 720 is enacted to read:

	SWIMMING
	§7891. Rules on restriction of swimming
	1. Rules. The commissioner shall promulgate rules
	restricting swimming in bodies of water determined by the
	commissioner to be hazardous. These rules must be adopted in
	accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act after
	public hearings in the areas affected.
	2. Prohibitions. The commissioner shall prohibit swimming
	in areas such as channels, marinas and rivers that the
	commissioner determines are hazardous due to the volume of
1	watercraft operating in the areas, or where swimming threatens
	public safety or adversely affects the natural environment.

	STATEMENT OF FACT
	This bill gives the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and
	Wildlife the ability to prohibit, through rulemaking, swimming in
	areas that the commissioner determines are hazardous. The
	prohibitions would be enforced by the Bureau of Warden Service.
