SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 390, L.D. 525, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Sales Tax Exemption for Emergency Shelter and Feeding Organizations"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in the first line (page 1, line 32 in amendment) by striking out the following: "1995" and inserting in its place the following: '1996'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

1996-97

REVENUES

General Fund	(\$5,834)
Other Funds	(314)

The additional sales tax exemption for emergency shelter and feeding organizations will decrease General Fund revenue by \$5,834 in fiscal year 1996-97. The corresponding decrease in State-Municipal Revenue Sharing will be \$314.'
