## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 390, L.D. 525

The additional sales tax exemption for emergency shelter and feeding organizations will decrease General Fund revenue by \$5,834 in fiscal year 1995-96 and \$9,630 in fiscal year 1996-97. The corresponding decreases in state-municipal revenue sharing will be \$314 and \$518, respectively.'
