Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §482, sub-§2, as repealed and replaced by PL 1993, c. 680, Pt. C, §7, is amended to read: 4 б 2. Development that may substantially affect the "Development that may substantially affect environment. the 8 environment," in this article also called "development," means any federal, state, municipal, quasi-municipal, educational, 10 charitable, residential, commercial or industrial development that: 12 Occupies a land or water area in excess of 20 acres; Α. 14 в. Contemplates drilling for or excavating natural 16 resources on land or under water where the area affected is in excess of 60,000 square feet; 18 C. Is a mining or advanced exploration activity as defined 20 in this section: Is a structure as defined in this section; or 22 D. 24 Ε. Is a subdivision as defined in this section. 26 "Development" does not include a borrow pits pit regulated under article 7. or a former federal military base previously exempt 28 from this chapter that is transferred to a state or local development authority, except to the extent development is proposed on that base after the transfer and this development 30 otherwise meets the definition of "development." 32 34 STATEMENT OF FACT 36 This bill excludes a former federal military base from the definition of "development" in the site location of development 38 laws except that development proposed on that base after its 40 transfer to a development authority is not excluded.
