This amendment, which is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Natural Resources, replaces the bill. Under current law, the Land for Maine's Future Board may expend

funds to take land by eminent domain if the expenditure or the acquisition has been approved by the Legislature or the owner of the land consents.
