COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 199, L.D. 542, Bill, "An Act to Include the Law Court's Imprisonment Sentencing Procedure in the Maine Criminal Code"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1252-C." in subsection 3 by striking out all of the last sentence (page 1, lines 30 to 32 in L.D.).

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment strikes language regarding the place of imprisonment or commitment, as it is not part of the 3-step sentencing procedure and is only misleading.
