COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 206, L.D. 549, Bill, "An Act to Give the State a Right to Appeal from the Denial of a Rule 35 Motion"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The additional costs to handle an insignificant number of new appeals can be absorbed by the Department of the Attorney General utilizing existing budgeted resources. The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
